We have some large projects which will be in some phase of testing/going live over the summer. The intern will assist to QA those systems. We are implementing a new eCommerce system – Magento 2 as well as an Inventory Management system and a new Accounting System (based on Salesforce) in our organization. There will be various phases of activity, but we believe the intern would be most useful in helping to test the system against requirements and log those defects so our developers can fix them. This will expose the intern to all of the phases of software development and real world examples of the trade-offs needed to launch large projects.
