

NEILOM FOUNDATION SOCIAL IMPACT INTERNS: SUMMER 2021

**ARE YOU INTERESTED IN CREATING POSITIVE SOCIAL IMPACT
USING TECHNOLOGY AT A NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION?**

The Neilom Foundation Social Impact Interns Program pairs undergraduate or graduate students with local non-profit organizations working in the social impact sector for a paid summer internship. Students will use their technical skills to work on a social impact project at these organizations. **Each candidate will be paid at least \$15 an hour by the host organization.** Women and minorities are strongly encouraged to apply.



WHO CAN APPLY TO BECOME A NEILOM INTERN FOR SUMMER 2021?

Any current undergraduate (sophomore+) or graduate students who are majoring/minoring in STEM fields at The George Washington University, University of Maryland, Morgan State University, Catholic University or Johns Hopkins University.

WHEN IS THE APPLICATION PERIOD AND HOW CAN I APPLY?

Applications are open now and will close April 16, 2021 for the Summer 2021 internships. You can view the open positions and apply by visiting our website at www.neilom.org/interns.

WHAT KIND OF WORK DOES THE INTERNSHIP ENTAIL?

Neilom internships are designed to offer students substantial and meaningful work on a project using technology to create social impact. No more than 10% of the work should be administrative work. Each organization is unique, and you can learn more about each position at www.neilom.org/interns.

IF I SUBMIT AN APPLICATION, DOES THAT MEAN I WILL BE PARTNERED WITH AN ORGANIZATION?

No, it is not guaranteed that you will be placed with an organization simply by applying. Each organization will have the chance to interview the top candidates chosen by the Neilom Foundation. Students will be notified of selection status by April 19th, 2021.

HOW MUCH WILL I BE PAID?

Specific pay logistics will be worked out with host organizations upon hiring with the understanding that all interns are paid at least \$15 an hour for 20 hours per week, over a 10 week period from June 7th through August 13th, 2021.
